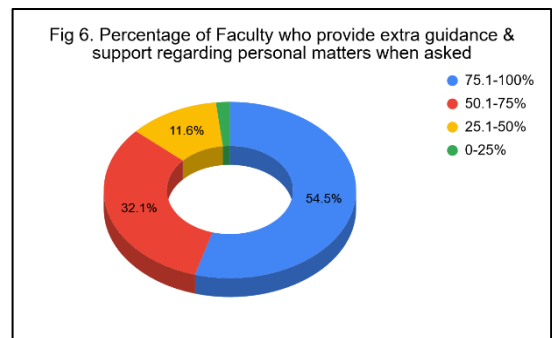
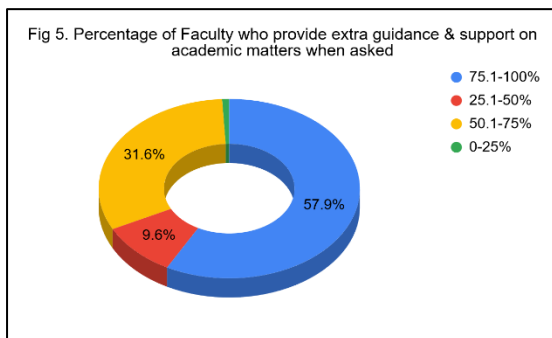
**Feedback from alumni was taken on different aspects of their university experience.**



Majority of graduating students acknowledged that faculty implement what they teach in classroom about patient management (93.8% faculty) and about ward behaviour and patient empathy (93% faculty).

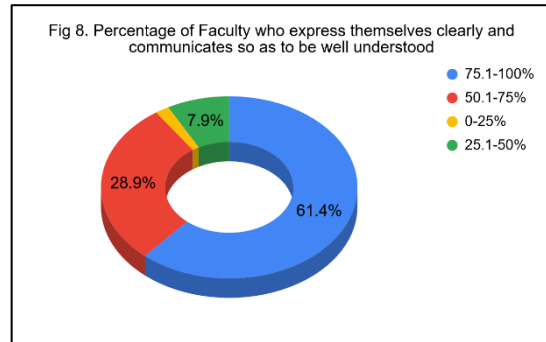
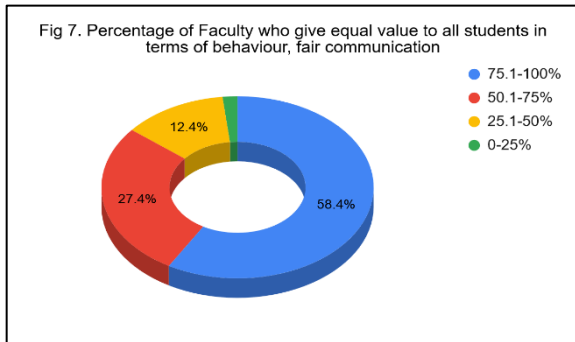


Majority of alumni expressed the view that 86.8% of faculty consider patient's personal situation during communication, examination and treatment. 89.5% of faculty were acknowledged to respect the dignity and self-respect of all students.

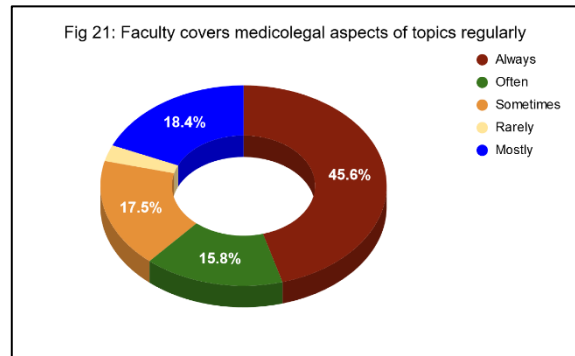
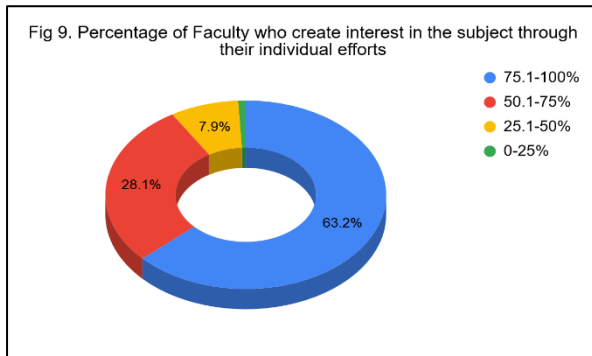


As per alumni, majority of faculty provide extra guidance and support on both academic matters (89.5%) and on personal matters (85.6%) when asked.

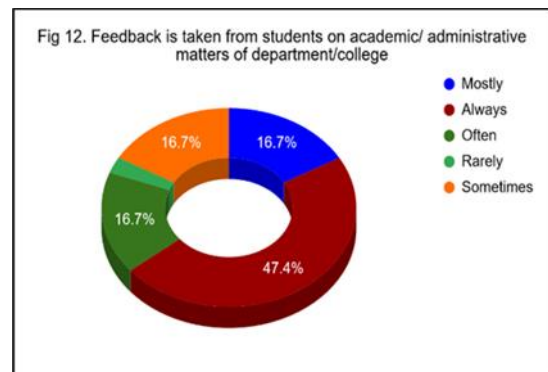
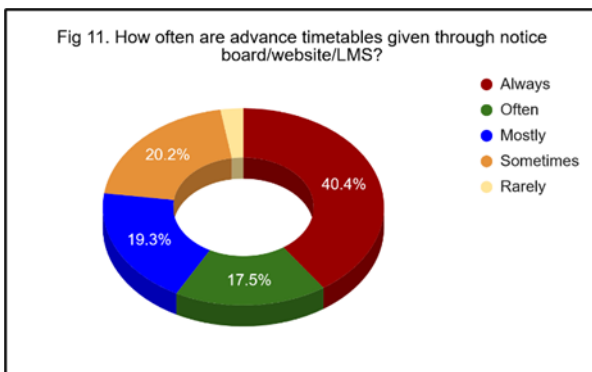

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Alumni reported that majority faculty give equal value to all students in terms of behaviour and communication (85.8% faculty) and express themselves clearly (90.3%).

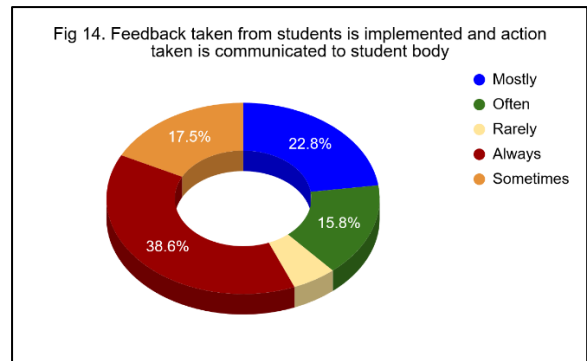
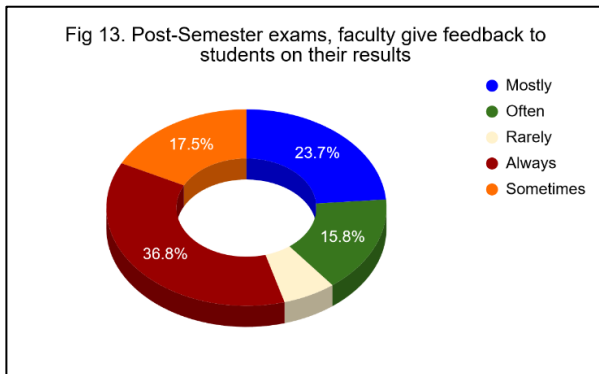

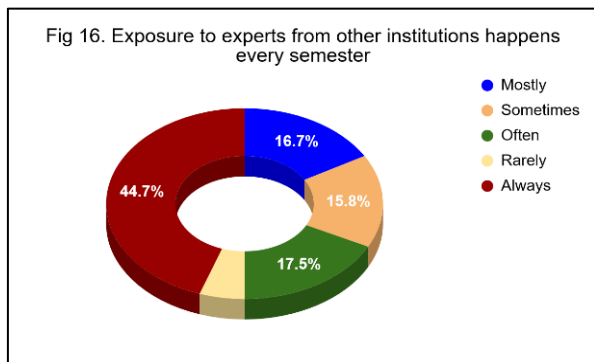
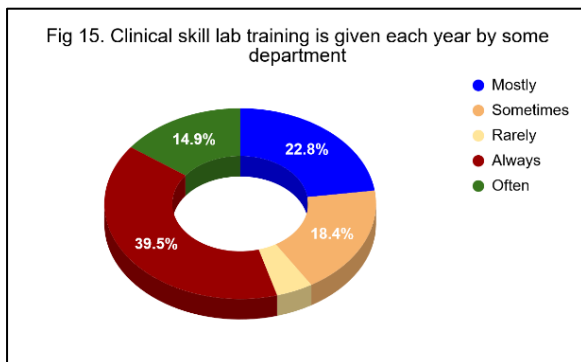
It was reported by 20.2% of respondents that timetables are given through noticeboard/website /LMS only sometimes.

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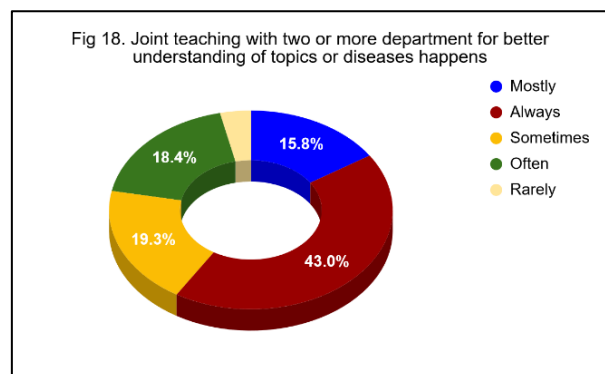
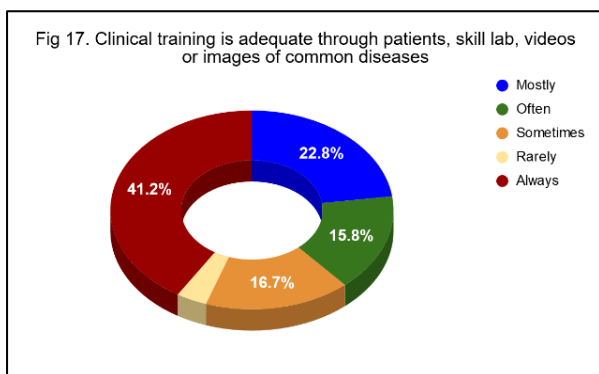


Respondents agreed that majority faculty (60.5%) give feedback to students either always or mostly post-semester examinations. Also Majority graduates (61.4%) reported that feedback is taken and implemented with action taken report communicated.

In area of academic training, majority agreed that Clinical Skill Lab training is given

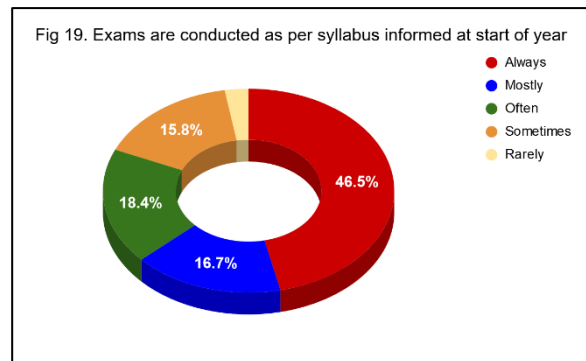
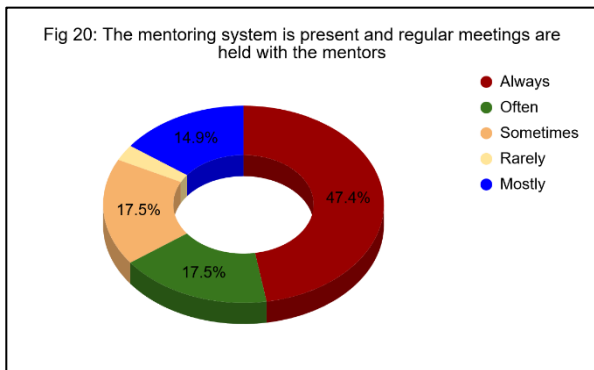


each year to them and exposure to experts from other institutions happens every semester.



Majority graduates agreed on adequacy of clinical training and that joint teaching is undertaken by departments.

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Majority graduates (64.3%) agreed that regular mentoring meetings are held with mentors through the mentoring system. Respondents (63.2%) reported that exams are conducted as per syllabus informed at start of year.

**Respondent Description:**

Of the graduates who responded, 65.5% were males and 40.6% had been members of the Student Council during their program years. Graduates reported that 16.8% were involved in the Students Wing of Bioethics, 34.6% participated in intercollege competitions and 63.6% had participated either as volunteers or participants for university/college conferences, seminars etc.
