Item No.-6 To consider to give weight-age for Internal Assessment for PG students.

(**Note:** The Medical College conducts internal examinations for PG students every year, separately for the first, second and third year students. PG Degree students complete three internal assessments and PG Diploma students complete two internal assessments. In order to increase its importance and creating awareness among students, it is necessary to give weight-age to these internal assessments. It is therefore, proposed that every student must secure 40% of marks aggregate in all 3/2 internal assessments for qualifying to appear for University examination. This is placed for consideration.)

Resolution: Resolved to approve to give weight-age of 40% of marks of Internal Assessment for qualifying-eligibility for appearing for PG examination.

Item No.-7 To consider revision of syllabus and examination pattern of first MBBS.

[A copy of revised syllabus and examination pattern is enclosed herewith.]

(**Note:** A meeting of the Board of Studies in Pre-Clinical was held on 26-07-2012 to consider the revision of syllabus and examination pattern of first MBBS. Before this, the departmental committee meetings were held in this regard. The revised syllabus and examination pattern of first MBBS recommended by the BOS is placed for consideration.)

Item No-8 To consider revision of Paper Pattern for MD Physiology.

(**Note:** A meeting of the Board of Studies in Pre-Clinical was held on 26-07-2012. The Board of Studies discussed and revised Paper Pattern for MD Physiology and recommended the same for approval to Academic Council.)

Item No-9 Report on Admissions in M.Sc. Medical Physics and M.Sc. Stem Cell & Regenerative Medicine & Ph.D.

(**Note:** The advertisement notification was published in daily Pudhari (23.06.2012 & 07.07.2012) and Times of India (02.07.2012) and the applications were invited. The All India Common Entrance Tests were held on 07.07.2012 and 13.07.2012. The University assessed the papers and conducted their personal interviews and selected the students as follows:

Item No-10 To consider declaration of Rank/Merit.

(**Note:** The students who have passed the Final year examination of MBBS, Nursing, B.P.Th. and have secured highest number of marks are enquiring about the Rank/Merit Certificate. Whether Rank/Merit may be declared for first five(s) candidates, who have passed the final examination in one and same appearance and have secured more than 60% marks amongst the successful candidates.

Hence this is placed for consideration.)

Resolution: Resolved to declare Rank/Merit as proposed.

Item No-11 To consider standard of passing of Post Graduate Practical.

(**Note:** As per the existing syllabus of the MD/MS/Diploma courses, the University has declared the results and issued the subject-wise statements of marks as under:

However in the syllabus, the provision of standard of passing: minimum marks for practical exam are shown. Some examples are as under:

MD Medicine	: 50% Separate in Clinical & Viva voce
MD Anatomy	: 50% Separate in Practical & Viva voce
DCH	: 50% Separate in Clinics & Viva voce

The Clinical & Viva voce are the sub-heads under the Head of Practical and these are not separate heads of Passing. It is, therefore, following uniform provision is suggested instead of above:

“Minimum passing marks in Practical:50%”

Hence it is placed for consideration.)

Resolution: Resolved to approve standard of passing of Post Graduate Practical as “Minimum passing marks in Practical:50%”.

Item No-12 To consider declaration of First Class with Dist., Ist Class, IInd Class and “Distinction” in the subject/s of MD/MS/PG Diploma/MBBS/B.Sc.(N)/P.B.B.Sc. (N) & B.P.Th.Course.

(**Note:-** As provided in syllabus, the students who have appeared and passed the MD/MS/PG Diploma/MBBS/ B.Sc. (N)/P.B.B.Sc. (N) & B.P.Th. Examinations with 50% marks in each of the subjects are declared to have **passed** in the said examination only. There is no provision of awarding class. However, MUHS, Nashik and some Deemed Universities declare “DISTINCTION” in the subject/s, who have secured 75% and above marks in that particular subject/s. Some Deemed Universities award “DECLARATION OF CLASS” as under.

- a) A candidate who appeared in all the subjects in the same examination and passed that examination in First attempt and secures 75% of marks or more of grand total marks prescribed, will be declared to have passed the examination **First Class with Distinction**.
- b) A candidate who appeared in all the subjects in the same examination and passed that examination in First attempt and secures 65% of marks or more but less than 75% of grand total marks prescribed, will be declared to have passed the examination in **First class**.
- c) A candidate who appeared in all the subjects in the same examination and passed that examination in First attempt and secures 55% of marks or more but less than 65% of grand total marks prescribed, will be declared to have passed the examination in **Second class**.
- d) A candidate, passing the University Examination in more than one attempt shall be placed in **pass class** irrespective of the percentage of marks secured by him/her in the examination.

This is placed for consideration.)

Resolution: Resolved to approve declaration of First Class with Dist., Ist Class, IInd Class and “Distinction” in the subject/s of MD/MS/PG Diploma/MBBS/B.Sc.(N)/P.B.B.Sc. (N) & B.P.Th.Course.
