

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR ADMISSION

1. PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION (Ph.D.)

- a) The University shall admit doctoral students through an Entrance Test and personal interview conducted at the all India level.
- b) Those students who qualify UGC/CSIR (JRF) Examination/SLET/GATE/ or any other fellowship holder or have passed M.Phil. programmes are directly invited for personal interview.
- c) At the time of interview, the candidates are expected to discuss their research interest/area.
- d) Only the predetermined number of students may be admitted to Ph.D. programme
