

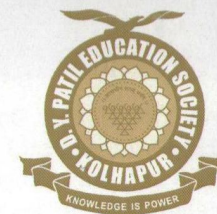

Preamble:

D. Y. Patil Education Society (Institution Deemed to be University) was established on 1st September 2005 under Section 3 of the UGC Act 1956. Since then, the University has developed into a premier educational institutes in the country offering undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in various disciplines in Medicine and Interdisciplinary fields, fulfilling the aspirations of students hailing from several parts of the country. The University comprises of a Medical College and Nursing College which are actively engaged in teaching at UG, PG and Diploma levels as well as a Centre for Interdisciplinary Research all of which undertake advanced research in emerging areas and on socially relevant themes. The University is also proud of its recent national and international recognitions such as,

- The University has been placed at rank 97 in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) in 2018.

- D. Y. Patil Medical College has been ranked 15 amongst all medical colleges in the country and ranked 03 Medical College in the West Zone, in special issue of India Today, in 2017.

- The University has been reaccredited as 'A' Grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2017.

The University is basically a Health Sciences University and has adopted the policy of intensification of research in various branches of medical and allied sciences, in addition to its teaching and extension activities. In fulfillment of this, the University has not only encouraged its faculty but also P.G. (MD/MS/ M.Sc.) Students to do research right from first year of admissions and their research is monitored and evaluated continuously for all three years of tenure of their study by organizing "Campaign on University Research & Training (COURT)" activity conducted on 18th February of every year. The 1st and 2nd year students make the presentation on their topic of research for PG thesis in the form of posters, while the final year students report their results in the platform presentation. These presentations are evaluated by assessors who also rank the students for awards given to them. In addition, the final year P.G. students are made compulsory to write a research paper based on their PG thesis in prescribed format for its publication in University Research Journal. Thus, the publication of research paper by the students is an integral part of curriculum of the PG programme.

The training of how to write the research papers to be published in the international journals is an innovative and noteworthy exercise of our University which has helped in attracting young medical doctors and researchers to medical and interdisciplinary research. The members of editorial board of the journal are strictly following the reviewing procedure with the help of experts in the field. The journal has resulted into the mirror image of the research work carried out in the University and the papers published therein are referred by many others. We are very happy to let the readers know about the outcome of our efforts which has resulted into featuring the research papers from our University researchers in "Top 20 Publications" at global level. The University is also conducting full time Ph.D. programs in five different areas of Medical & Allied sciences under the umbrella of "Centre for Interdisciplinary Research". It is a proud moment for every PG student when they have research publications based on their PG original research work.
