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## INTRODUCTION

D.Y. Patil Education Society (Institution Deemed to be University), Kolhapur declared under section 3 of the UGC Act 1956 on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2005.

Motto: 'Dnyanadheenam Jagat Sarvam' Guided by well-defined, clearly articulated Vision, Mission and Goals, the university offers contemporary & innovative programs through its Medical College, College of Nursing and the Centre for Interdisciplinary Research. Skill based employability-driven programs include DMLT, OT Technician Training Certificate, Dialysis Technician Certificate in addition to MBBS, MD/MS, Medical Fellowships, B.Sc., P.B.B.Sc. and MSc Nursing, B.Sc. Hospitality Studies, B. Physiotherapy, MSc programs in Medical Physics, Stem Cell and Regenerative Medicine, Medical Biotechnology and Doctoral programs in Interdisciplinary and Medical subjects. Organisational values of transparency, participative management and decentralisation are reflected in quality assurance systems like, modernisation of examinations, monitoring of Heads of Departments and statutory and non-statutory bodies. Peer-assess Annual Quality Assurance Exercise since 2018 attests to the continuous pursuit of quality in all aspects. Feedback from different stakeholders is used to assess, improve and excel. University has committed to program expansion of skill-based employment and self-employment oriented programmes in Allied Health Sciences. An ISO: 9001-2015 certified 800-bedded multispecialty Hospital provides academic, clinical training and a research platform. State-of-the-Art Simulation & Skill Centre is initiated. Free rural medical camps and subsidized treatment ensure access of primary to tertiary services to the poorest. In keeping with Digital India mission, e-governance and pervasive use of computerisation and technology promote paper-less offices. Extensive use of ICT includes latest technological education aids such as LCDs, Smart Boards, Visualizers, Manikins and Simulations. Digital Library, e-database subscription (Pro-Quest, Pro-Quest Ebrary, INFLIBNET, NKN, MUHS e-resources), Telemedicine, Wi-Fi campus, OPAC, updated websites contribute to the 'Digital India' vision. A customized Learning Management System allows for better curriculum delivery. Meets Statutory and Global needs. A globally relevant and locally applicable curriculum of international standards with Outcome based training is achieved through Clinical Skill Labs, Cadaveric Skill Lab, an active Medical Education Training Unit, adoption of the latest pedagogy and assessment methods. Incorporation of research in UG and PG programs, evidence-based teaching, interactive and case-based learning, early clinical exposure, industry based experiential learning, industry-academia collaborations, remedial classes and emphasis on field work ensure our graduates are competitive for higher education and employment. Presently the University hosts a DST-Inspire Fellow Dr. Umakant Patil and a Ramanujan Fellow Dr. J. L. Gunjekar. Ms. Shital Kale was awarded the SERB Overseas Fellowship. This has been possible due to experienced faculty coordinated Comprehensive Research Promotion Practices and requisite administrative and financial support. Research projects funded by ICMR, IGIB, DST and by the University are undertaken at facilities like Advanced Research Facilities, Animal House, Instrumentation lab, 3-D Printers, Stem Cell Research facility, Molecular Biology Lab, Central Laboratory at the hospital, RICH Cell (Research in Comprehensive Health). Research output

includes Patents, Books, Chapters, Conference Proceedings and Research Publications ranging from case reports to original articles. MoUs and Collaborations in India, Australia, Sweden, South Korea, Taiwan, Nigeria, UK countries give us global relevance. Regular organisation of National, International Conferences, Workshops and Seminars are joined by a plethora of Guest Lectures organised in the campus. These, along with support to faculty to participate in external professional events ensures competency updated teachers' strength. Other initiatives include Research certification of Undergraduates, annual research events for UG (Second MBBS Alliance for Research and Training) and PG (Campaign of University Research and Training) an Doctoral (Dnyanshodh, Anveshan) students, Research Methodology workshops for UG, PG and Pre-PhD students, student exchange, faculty exchange, hosting and invited talks. The complement of 155 Postgraduate students and 89 PhD scholars and post-doctoral fellows carry out research in basic sciences and clinical areas as well as in emerging areas of nanomaterials, stem cell & regenerative medicine, medical physics, targeted drug delivery, nanobiotechnology, biosensors etc. Holistic student development is a priority. Measures such as University Moral Guidance Scheme, Student Guardianship Program, Student Councils, PG Club, NSS, Gender Sensitization and Women Development Cell, Internal Complaint Cell, Anti-Discrimination Cell, Student's Grievance Cell, Entrepreneurship Cell, Anti-ragging cell, Campus Placement Cell, Student Welfare Cell all contribute to providing a motivating and supportive environment conducive to optimising personal and professional potential of students. Universal values and skills are integrated in student training through Students Bioethics Wing of UNESCO Bioethic Unit, NSS, soft-skills training, Language class, Counselling Centre, mentoring programs, career counselling, celebration of National days, social gatherings, sports and extracurricular activities. Students participate in programs such as Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan, Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan, Swachhata-hi-Seva, Rural Community Oriented Medical Training, Beti-BachaoBeti-Padhao, Handwashing campaign, clean our Schools campaign, Stop Plastic campaign, Save the Girl Child as also in social awareness walkathons, street plays, skits and roadshows. A conscionable ISR yielded Public-Private Partnerships encompassing one Urban and four Primary Health Centers and one Rural Health training Center, Village Adoption program, five-village adoption under Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan program and RCOMET (Rural Community Oriented Medical Training) at four villages in Kolhapur District. The Family Health Insurance scheme launched by the Hospital ensures highly subsidized, affordable, State-of-the-Art primary and secondary health care to the populace. Go-Green Initiatives include using LED lights, roof-top solar panels, biogas plants, sewage treatment plants, recycling of e-waste, biomedical and sewage waste, composting, oxygen nodes, tree plantations etc. in our campus, in addition to spreading awareness and education in the rural areas adopted. Twice in succession the campus has been shortlisted in the National Swachh Bharat competition for educational institutions. Every successive accomplishment serves to bolster our enthusiasm, strengthen our belief and motivates us to do what Sam Levenson said, "Don't watch the clock; do what it does. Keep going."

In the above activities/events the gender perspective and opportunities were predominantly considered.

## **GENDER SENSITIVE FEATURES OF THE UNIVERSITY**

But through a network of security personal and CCTV Cameras the University has assured a safe and healthy atmosphere. Any unwarranted incident especially related to women's safety is curtailed through this mechanism.

Around 2000 girls are accommodated in two Ladies hostels on the campus, which paves the way for easy access to women's education.

To address the health (both physical & psychological) issues of all stakeholders, especially female employees and students, a female medical officer and a gynecologist are available at health Centre. Similarly one Counselor help female students on the campus, to deal with their psychological problems and motivate them.

The University has Anti Ragging Committee and Internal Complaints Committee to maintain healthy and fearless atmosphere. Both these Committees are organizing awareness raising programs.

The University has taken a path breaking decision of drafting a Gender Policy. This Policy document guides all University stakeholders while formulating policy, taking decision, recruiting the staff, creating infrastructure etc. This is a guiding document to bring about gender parity at the institute.

Birth Anniversaries of important social reformers especially Savitribai Phule, Ahilyabai Holkar, Matoshri Jijabai, Chhatrapati Tararani are celebrated.

Women's representation in every Committee is a well established practice at the University. This facilitates not only gender justice but the work of the Committee gets a gender perspective.

### ALL DEPARTMENTS AND ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING EQUIPPED WITH CLEAN LADIES WASHROOM

There are adequate number of toilets in the building with 24 hours water availability and daily cleanliness facility. In the Departments, students movement is maximum; hence there is a great deal of need to have clean toilets and complaint box. Following Table illustrates the availability of both. University campus is protected by high compound wall on all sides. There is availability of security posts at every entrance gate with adequate security guards who work in shifts. Security personnel are appointed at important and sensitive places.

### LADIES HOSTEL

University has a Girls hostel which caters the needs of girl students from remote and rural areas. Hostel premises have a building and accommodate 142 students. The Policy of University that no girl student interested in seeking admission to the hostel is denied admission.

The above tables give information about hostel infrastructure and facilities available for girls.

University hostels provide Electric Geyser, Solar Water heater and drinking water facility for girls. To assure hygienic safety the hostel provides Vending machine and burning machine facility.

Hostel provides mess facility with good quality food and reasonable charges.

Hostel has two rectors. There are three night wardens on contract basis for safety of girls at night. The hostel rules are displayed on the walls of hostel.

Hostel is surrounded by a high security wall and 4 CCTV cameras are placed at various locations. Hostel has 24 hour security guards who work in shifts. Hostel subscribes various newspapers like Pudhari, Sakal, Lokmat, Lok-Satta and Times of India. Hostel also provides facilities like Television, indoor sports material and Gym for recreation and fitness. Hostel regularly organises medical checkups for girls.

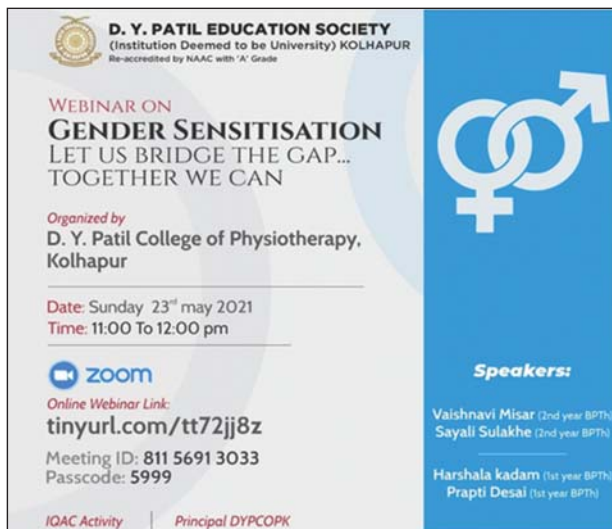

**Gender Audit Report of the Committee visit to  
D. Y. Patil Education Society, Kolhapur. (Institution deemed to be University)**

The External Gender Audit of D. Y. Patil Education Society, Kolhapur (Institution Deemed to be University) was conducted in order to enquire and assess to what extent the University has mainstreamed gender in its policies, programme, projects or services provided; whether targets and indicators include gender perspective in terms of progress by way looking into the extent to which gender integration has fostered the inclusion of women and whether benefits to women & men involved by the org. planning/policies/programs/projects/services by way of looking into whether Gender equality has been mainstreamed in high level policy objectives & priorities and see whether these attempts have led to closing the gender gaps, that women & men benefit equally or –are in accordance to their gender needs along with enquiring into whether inequalities are not perpetuated and whether the targets and indicators include gender perspective in terms of progress towards gender equality.

The Gender Audit conducted by the Committee, indicates that the following have been observed to be the 'Best practices'.

1. The university has maintained a gender segregated data on all the issues. Especially related to the students as well the staff working on the campus.
2. The university has displayed Boards related to the Gender equality –e.g. Anti Ragging, Internal Anti – Sexual Harassment Committee along with the contact details of each of the member official – The committees have been actively involved in their respective responsibilities
3. The university authorities are easily approachable. The survey points out that the faculty has been dedicated and are easily approachable. This has resulted in the educational progress with no barriers with a gender friendly environment within the classrooms as well as outside. Both – male and female students as well as the staff seemed to be gender sensitive
4. The mentoring system followed within the departments has helped in making the environment enabling girls' progression in higher education.
5. Financial support is provided by way of scholarships/funding projects as well as support & encouragement to the girl students and women staff to undertake research projects way and mentoring–driving the environment' enabling to progression in higher education.
6. Required physical facilities in the University campus which houses all Education departments and Administrative offices and the Ladies Hostel outside the campus – have been gender friendly, also addressing the issues of otherwise-able with alert security.
7. Gender awareness campaigns and workshops have been organized for the students within the campus.
8. Efforts are also made through gender sensitizing initiatives by the University by providing support to organize programmes on gender issues

9. The physical facilities are satisfactory as the University as they have the following provisions;
- There is an Internal Complaints Committee.
  - The hostels for girls and women Research scholars are well secured 24/7 personnel and a full time Lady Warden and ladies staff.
  - The Health Centre has a Lady Medical Officer.
  - There are CCTV monitoring devices installed at different locations within the campus especially the Library and major gates.
  - There is a Day care Centre for the children of the employees with attendants to take care of the child

**Suggestions :**

- The Finance department to maintain a Gender disaggregated data - in cases of Research projects, funding for participation in academic or sports activities. The approval/rejection record to be to be maintained in a gender disaggregated form.
- Each Department can be encouraged to maintain the gender segregated data.
- Number of activities and initiatives for- Awareness of right of women and Gender sensitivity to be centrally organized by the IQAC.
- Considering the large number of students, a post of Counselor needs to be created and a trained certified counselor needs to be recruited.
- Hostel facilities for girls and women may be uplifted and updated as per the latest changes and situational demand.
