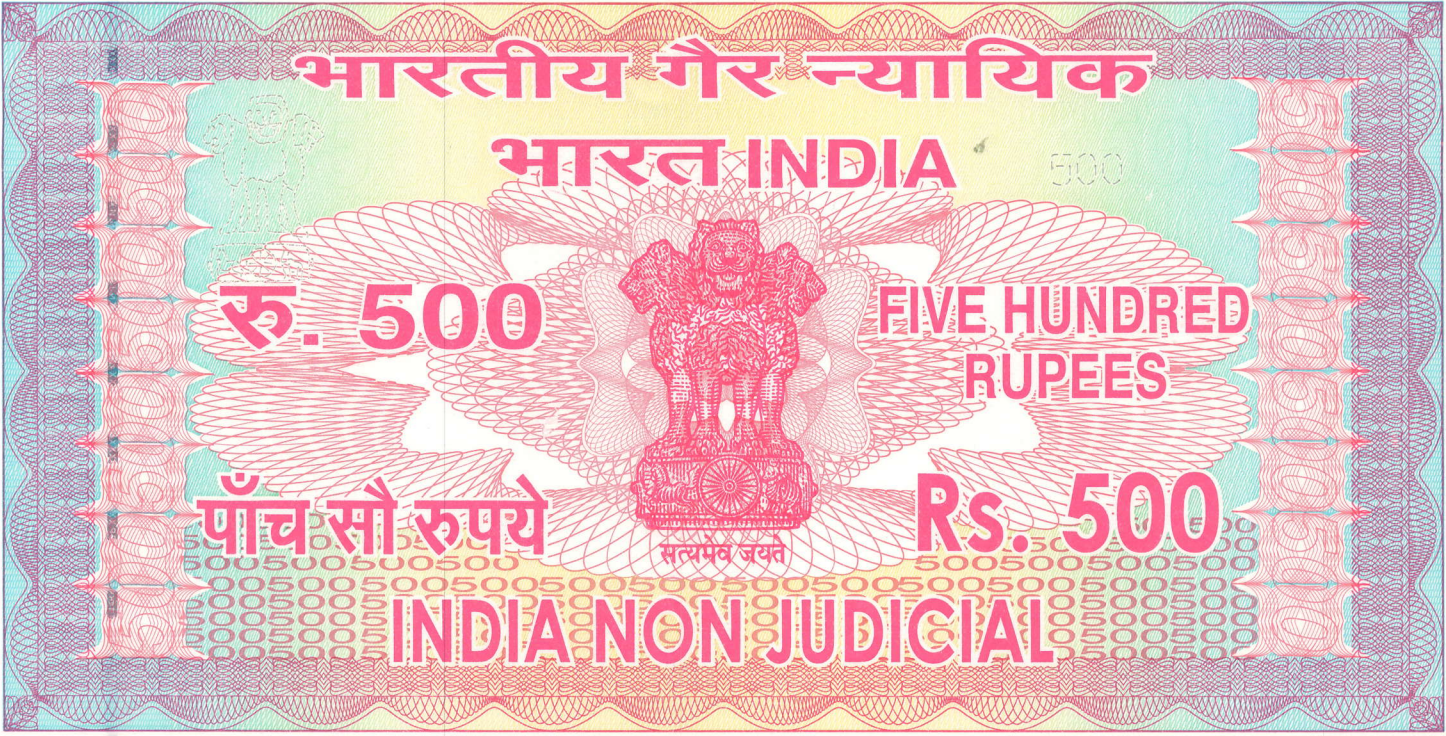

PARTY OF THE FIRST PART

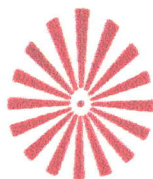
The D. Y. Patil Education Society (Deemed to be University) was established as notified by the then Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. The University offers P.G. programmes in Medicine, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Medical Physics, Medical Biotechnology, Stem Cell and Regenerative Medicine, Computer Applications and Business Administration and U.G. programmes in Medicine, nursing, Hospitality studies, Allied Health Sciences, Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Engineering & Technology, Management and Computer Applications. The University also offers Ph.D. programme in interdisciplinary areas. The 850 Bedded Multispecialty Hospital offers affordable, equitable, advanced Health care with well-equipped intensive care, modern operation theatres and sophisticated diagnostic facilities. The Medical College has highly sophisticated Simulation and Skills Center.

06. 'Best University' Award by Europe Business Assembly, Oxford, U.K.
07. D. Y. Patil Medical College adjudged as 'Best Institute' and awarded with "Pride of Maharashtra Award" in 2019 in Maharashtra Economics Summit, Mumbai.

PRAJAPITA BRAHMA KUMARIS ISHWARIYA VISHWA VIDYALAYA(PBKIVV), MOUNT ABU, (RAJASTHAN) having its headquarters at Pandav Bhawan, Mount Abu, Rajasthan 307501 represented herein by its manager which term shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof herein after be referred to as the

PARTY OF THE SECOND PART

Whereas PBKIVV is a well-known spiritual value-based educational institution which has gained global acceptance and recognition. There is worldwide acceptance of its teaching in around 130 countries, with over 5300 branches across continents. It is affiliated with the Department of Public Information(DPI) of the United Nations as a Non-Governmental organization (NGO). In the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) of the United Nations, it holds Consultative Status. It has consultative Status also with the UNICEF (UN Children's Fund). The United Nations 'University for Peace' in Costa Rica receives its cooperation in the field of peace education by means of an official agreement. This Vishwa Vidyalaya has been awarded UN Peace Medal for 1981 and 1986.

(The terms Party of the First Part and the Party of Second Part shall wherever the context so permit and mean, include their respective representatives, administrators/ assigns and successors-in-interest)

Whereas it is the view of both parties that the courses shall have a significant contribution to the holistic development of the individuals, particularly facilitating the personality development of students and faculty.

Whereas in terms of the above, the Parties have accordingly decided to enter into the instant Memorandum of Understanding on the terms and conditions enlisted hereunder:

NOW THIS DEED OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. Scope:

- 1.1. To offer the Courses to the students of DYPESDU. The students can take up these courses as value-added courses/certificate courses as per norms prescribed by DYPESDU from time to time.
- 1.2. The courses being offered under the auspices of the instant Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) are more fully set out with the consent of both PARTIES.

2. Tenure:

- 2.1. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be valid for a period of 5 years from the date of execution.
- 2.2. The MOU shall be renewed as may be necessary upon a mutual consensus between parties upon it being recorded in writing.

3. Objectives

- 3.1 To conduct VIHASA (Values in Health Care a Spiritual Approach) to all Healthcare professionals.
- 3.2 To conduct digital wellness, as a value-added course/certificate course to the students of University Departments of DYPESDU is offline mode.
- 3.3 HAPPI- Holistic Approach for Positive Powerful Inner self.
- 3.4 To conduct the courses, as value-added courses/certificate courses to the students of University Departments of DYPESDU by offline mode.
- 3.5 To facilitate collaboration of students and faculty with Institutions across the world for mutual development through Project works, Internships, Skill development, Seminar, Conferences and Research scholarships to enhance employment opportunities and enable them to position themselves in the appropriate social strata, through personality development.
- 3.6 To conduct Rajyog Programmes on International Yoga Day and similar events in collaboration with Departments, Centers and students' forums of DYPESDU.
- 3.7 Value education cell establishment and sustenance.
- 3.8 Self-development through spiritual tools
- 3.9 Establishment and sustenance of meditation room: inner space.
- 3.10 Mind spa incorporated in digital library.

4. Roles and Responsibilities of the Party of the First Part/ DYPESDU

- 4.1 DYPESDU shall be responsible for admissions and administrative work related to announcing, conduct and any assessment
- 4.2 DYPESDU shall admit students as per the rules, regulations and norms prescribed by the University from time to time.
- 4.3 The admission-related fee/course fee/exam fee if any, shall be collected and used by DYPESDU.
- 4.4 DYPESDU shall have the right to revise the program fee, duration, credits and other eligibilities to run the courses from time to time and the same shall be informed to the Party of the Second Part.
- 4.5 The admission eligibility, Attendance and Minimum pass mark in each course shall be as per the norms prescribed by DYPESDU from time to time.
- 4.6 The course certificate shall be jointly issued and awarded by the DYPESDU and PBKIVV as per the norms prescribed from time to time. The administrative work will be responsibility of DYPESDU.

5. Roles and Responsivities of Party of the Second Part/PBKIVV

- 5.1 Implementation of the courses: The courses and programmes under this MOU shall be undertaken by PBKIVV recognized faculties for students, staff and faculty of DYPESDU within India like cities of Pune, Mumbai, Goa and Mount Abu etc.
- 5.2 The travel expenses incurred for the deputed faculty members will be borne by DYPESDU, wherever applicable.
- 5.3 The course material and audio-visual presentations for the courses shall be prepared by the PBKIVV through its own faculty, as per the syllabus approved by the academic council of DYPESDU and agreed scheme of courses.
- 5.4 The Party of the Second Part shall execute the courses and monitor the quality of the courses as per the regulations framed by the Party of the First Part.

6. Mutual Obligations of the Parties

- 6.1 The Party of the First Part shall release advertisements with mutual discussion and intimation to the Party of the Second Part and in such cases, the cost shall be borne by DYPESDU.

6.2 The annual intake of applicants shall be decided by both the parties during the commencement of admission, which shall take place once in 6 months and the decision will be taken with mutual discussion.

6.3 Both the parties have agreed to prepare an application and prospectus bearing the logo of both the Parties, and the same shall be published for admission and course promotion by the Party of the First Part after the approval from the Party of the Second Part.

6.4 Any expansion, modification or alteration in relation to the said courses shall be decided jointly by both Parties.

6.5 All expenses related to this course will be borne by the DYPESDU. Expenses incurred, by PBKIVV will be reimbursed by DYPESDU from time to time.

7. Details of Programs to be Conducted

7.1 PBKIVV will conduct the course as follows

- A. VIHASA 8 Modules (One module 3 ½ hours 7 modules one day each)
- B. Digital Wellness Certificate Course (Completed within a semester)
- C. Deaddiction Program (Completed within a semester)

8. All other details of the program are attached as Annexure

COMMUNICATION: Any communication or notice or intimation shall be addressed to the following Single Point of Contact (Spoc) of the respective parties and sent to the registered address of the parties concerned and E-mail correspondence should not be taken as a substitute for any official signed hard copy correspondence in all important documents such as but not limited to financial and performance related documents.

9. Intellectual Property Rights:

9.1 Any intellectual property created solely in relation to or arising out of this MOU, by PBKIVV during the validity of MOU, or prior to the MOU, or after the

termination of MOU shall be under the sole and exclusive ownership of PBKIVV. Ownership of any intellectual property created/developed through collaborations between both the parties under this MOU will be determined between the Parties through mutual consultation and recorded in writing as an addendum/amendment/agreement separately on a case-to-case basis prior to starting of work.

All research emerging from the activities conducted under the MOU will be jointly published by PBKIVV and DYPESDU in journals approved by University.

10. Termination:

10.1 Each party shall be entitled to terminate for default this MOU, by operation of law and without demand, immediately: in case of material breach of this MOU by the other party if the defaulting Party has not remedied such breach within thirty (30) days of receiving such notice to cure the default.

10.2 This MOU shall terminate by operation of law and without demand, upon first occurrence of one of the following events:

Or

10.3 Mutual written agreement of the Parties to terminate the MOU: Or

10.4 Expiry of five years from the Effective Date of this MOU unless otherwise agreed by the Parties to extend it beyond this expiry date: Or

10.5 If either Party is prohibited under prevalent rules or notifications or laws from the relevant administration. In such cases no Party shall incur any liability whatsoever.

11. Liability and Indemnity

11.1 Each Party shall be solely responsible and liable for the actions and omissions of its employees, agents and assigns.

11.2 No party shall be liable to indemnify the loss caused to the other party if the loss caused is a result of their own actions.

11.3 If, however, the loss caused to a particular party has arisen as a result of the other party's actions, then the party which caused the loss shall be liable to indemnify the loss of the non-faulting party.

12. Variation

12.1 No variation of this Agreement shall be valid unless it is in writing and signed by or on behalf of each of the Parties to this Agreement.

13. Entire Agreement:

13.1 Save as provided herein, this Agreement embodies all the terms and conditions agreed upon between the Parties hereto as to the subject matter of this Agreement and supersedes and cancel any previous agreements, representations, warranties, discussion, understandings and/or undertakings amongst the Parties, written or oral or otherwise with respect to such subject matter.

13.2 This Agreement shall not be construed to be an arrangement between the parties in the nature of a Partnership, Association of Persons, Joint Venture Agreement or any control of a commercial nature.

13.3 The specific terms of this MOU do not preclude the development of future collaborative ventures or projects not mentioned in this document.

14. Assignment

The rights and obligations under this Agreement shall not be assigned or transferred in whole or in part by any party without the written consent of the other Parties.

15. Force Majeure

15.1 Either Party shall be excused from any delay or failure in performance required hereunder if caused by reason of any occurrence or contingency beyond its reasonable control, including, but not limited to, acts of God, acts of war, fire, insurrection, strikes, lockouts, epidemics, pandemics or other serious labour disputes, riots, earthquakes, floods, explosions or other acts of nature

15.2 The obligations and rights of the Party so excused shall be extended on a day-to-day basis for the time period equal to the period of such excusable interruption. When such events have abated, the Parties' respective obligations hereunder shall resume.

16. Dispute Resolution

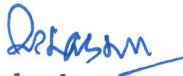
All disputes arising out of in connection with the instant Memorandum of Understanding shall be finally decided by Arbitration as per the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as has been amended from time to time.
