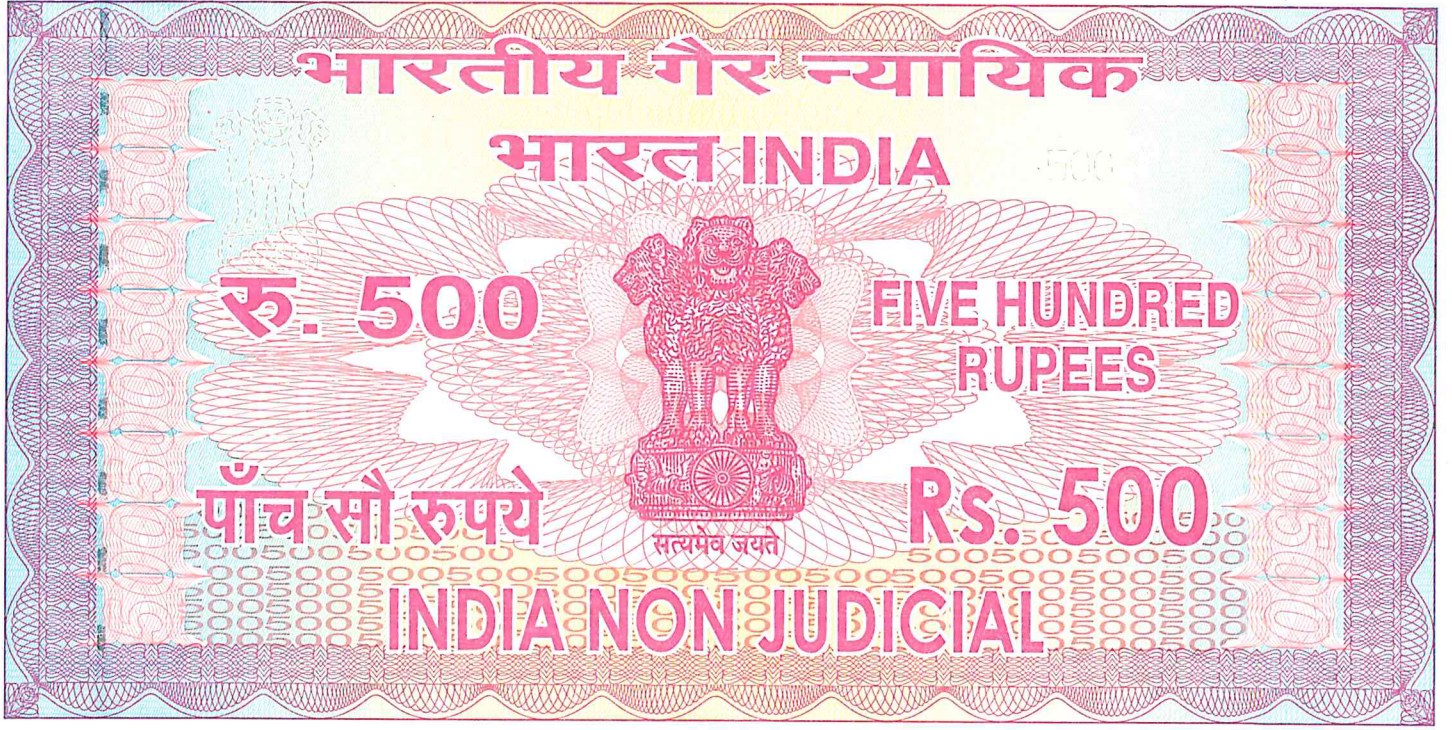

TRANSPORTATION, TREATMENT & DISPOSAL OF BIO-MEDICAL WASTE.

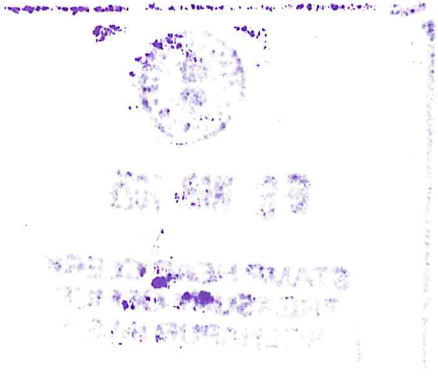

Whereas the party no. 2 is Authorized by Kolhapur Municipal Corporation & Maharashtra Pollution Control Board for operate Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment & Disposal Facility (CBMWTF) & doing the said above work as per the rule and regulations of Bio Medical Waste Management Rules 2016 & this agreement is executed between party No. 1 and party No. 2 from 01/04/2025 to 31/10/2049 as per the term & conditions Mentioned below.

Terms & conditions of agreement:

- 1) Party no. 1 will not mix any other waste in Bio medical Waste like food stuff, carry bags, fruits, papers, coconut, and flowers.
- 2) Party no. 1 will co-operate to deliver the Biomedical Waste to the collection van without any hesitation. They know very well that un-segregated & without Bar Code Bio-medical waste bag/container will not collected by party no. 2 & party no. 1 agreed to give biomedical waste at one collection point within prescribed time.
- 3) Party no. 1 should regularly maintain proper record for segregation & transportation of bio medical Waste. Both the parties are abiding to sign on their service / visit book whether the waste material is available or not.

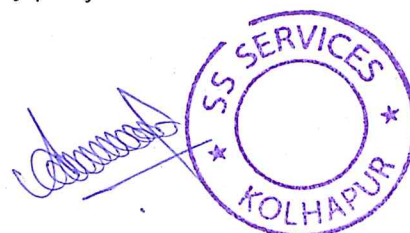


4) The collected Bio- Medical Waste to dispose as per norms it is responsibility of party no. 2.

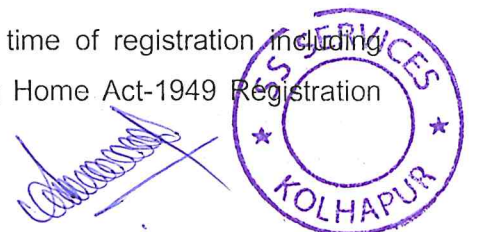
5) The bio- medical waste generated by hospitals is defined as follows:

As per above chart, all the Bio Medical Waste to be segregate and store in prescribed bags with barcode which are having specific color codes& category (Yellow, Red, Blue and White) as per CPCB & MPCB rules. The waste material is to be segregated by party no. 1.



- 6) The Registration, transportation & treatment / disposal charges of Bio-Medical waste will be as under:-
- a) Onetime Registration charges -Rs. 3,000/- (In word Rs. Three Thousand only)
 - b) Treatment & Disposal charges -Rs. 8.03/- (In word Rs. Eight Rupees and three paise only) per month,
 - c) The taxes will be charged extra as per rules.
 - d) BMW Collection Bag, Dustbin, Container & Bar code will be charge extra.
 - e) Covid 19 & any pandemic (like Covid 19) Bio Medical Waste Treatment & Disposal Charges Rs. 100/- (In word rs. one hundred only) per kg & Covid 19 Bio Medical Waste Transportation Charges Rs. 15,000/- (In word rs. fifteen thousand only) per month.
- 7) The party no. 1 will pay the payment for collection, transportation and disposal is to be paid annually in advance per financial year before expiry of Membership Certificate (Bio Medical Waste Management Certificate). Party no. 2 will issue receipt of the same.
- 8) Every three years 10% agreed charges will be increased in para no. 6 of this agreement.
- 9) If the party no. 1 fails to make the payment regularly as per agreement, the party no. 2 will wait up to 2 months and after that party no. 2 will stop the service and inform to Government authority ie. MPCB, local body, Collector, District Health Officer / Civil Surgeon / Medical Health Officer. The concern institute will be responsible for further cause and consequence which will be adore in future.
- 10) Party no. 1 shall renew Membership Certificate (Bio Medical Waste Management Certificate) before 30 days of expiry date, if not renewed by Party no. 1 within this period, party no. 2 have right to take decision about service stop or 10% penalty per month will be applicable after such period.
- 11) On the day of Government & National holidays, Curfew, Band etc. service will be not able to provide by the party no. 2, but during this period generated all Bio Medical Waste will collected on next day.
- 12) Both parties agreed to inform each other regarding any service related complaint of Bio-Medical waste segregation or collection& other issues within 24 hrs.
- 13) Party no. 1 shall submit the documents to party no. 2 at the time of registration including Maharashtra Pollution Control Board Consent, Bombay Nursing Home Act-1949 Registration



Certificate, Local Body NOC, Doctor Degree Certificate, Registration Certificate & any other concern Authority certificate.

- 14) Party no. 1 will not allow to untreated bio medical waste shall be kept / stored in premises.
- 15) The total system will be carried out as per CPCB & MPCB rules and regulation by law of Bio Medical Waste Management rules 1998 & 2016, the respected amendment for the both the laws will be corporate as and whenever published.
- 16) It is necessary for the party No. 2 to collect the Bio- Medical waste as per Bio Medical Waste Management rules 1998 & 2016 from consent institute if Party No.2 (Contractor) fails to do it then he will be answerable to MPCB at any time.
- 17) Injection needles should be terminated within the institute. Hence needle terminator should be kept in institute. This is mandatory by the rules.
- 18) Any type of BMW including plastic waste ie. IV sets / bottles, syringesshould be given to party No. 2only. It is not allowed to sale in the scrapor dispose at any other public place. For this type of mistake only party No. 1 will be held responsible.
- 19) If the institute/hospital will remain closed for year or more, any changes in number of beds, address, name change the concerning institution must convey this advance in writing.
- 20) The concerning institute/hospital have their duty to arrange training &make aware regarding the Bio-Medical waste to their staff.
- 21) It is mandatory on both the parties to renew the contract before 60 days of its expiry date.
- 22) The both parties shall strictly follow the term and conditions. No claim willbe entertained their after.
- 23) Kolhapur Municipal Corporation appointed to M/s. S S Services, Kolhapur as operator of Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facility for the period of 29 (Twenty Nine) years for from Oct 2020.
- 24) The agreement will be valid for a period of 29 (Twenty Nine)year ie. April 2024 to Oct 2049.
