VISION

To achieve global standards in healthcare credibility and delivery by reducing risk of hospital infection and improving patient safety.

MISSION

- ♦ To institute quality preventive measures to reduce hospital acquired infections
- ♦ To engage in periodic and regular monitoring and surveillance of the hospital sites to identify areas for improvement.
- ♦ To put in place systems that inspire patient trust and doctor confidence to enable the delivery of quality patient care
- ♦ To build a system of following infection control practices at all levels of health workers.

Quality Assurance for Hospital Infection Control Policy

- ♦ **Quality Assurance will be assured through following efforts:**
 1. Operation theatre asepsis and periodic operation theatre surveillance
 2. Carrier study of staff and food handlers
 3. Water analysis
 4. Safe and timely waste management
 5. Monitoring of patients and their relatives movement in hospital
 6. Immunization of hospital staff
 7. Epidemiological investigation of outbreaks of communicable diseases
 8. Awareness programs amongst health care workers
 9. Prescription vigilance and formulation of antibiotic guidelines
 10. Sterilization control and testing of disinfectants.
