





**Report of Rural Community Oriented Medical education
& Training (RCOMET) Programme at Village Hanbarwadi**

Rural Community Oriented Medical education & Training Programme (R-COMET) was scheduled and conducted from 15/05/18 to 17/05/18 at Village Hanbarwadi by department of Community Medicine, for IV term students (Batch - D -35 students).

Day 1- 15/05/18.

Departure of IVth term students (Batch - D), faculty members & MSWs from Dept. of Community Medicine to Village Hanbarwadi at 9:30 a.m. Individual introduction of each student and staff was given. Students interacted with village representatives and stake holders.

Students were divided into groups A,B,C and D. Group consists of 10 students. The social workers assisted the students in orienting them at the ground level. One family per student was allotted for collection of all information of the family and their housing and environmental conditions. Family Survey was completed at 02:00 pm followed by lunch.

Post lunch session was followed by cultural activities, debriefing of activities and data collection was done. Tea and Snacks were served at 05:00pm followed by a discussion on the collected family data. Students identified some problem areas in the community which were discussed with supervising teachers. Each group was given a identified problem area for community intervention to be worked upon next day. These problem areas are as follows,

Group A: Personal Hygiene, Group C : Lifestyle Modification Group B: Nutrition, Group D : Breast Feeding

The team returned to college by 06:30pm.

Day 2 - 16/05/18.

Departure of students & staff from D. Y. Patil Medical College at 09:00am.

Students visited Primary Health Centre Ispurli at 10:00 a.m. Dr. J. S. Shete Assistant Prof., Dept. of Community Medicine briefed the students about the Healthcare delivery system in the rural setup. He also gave information of

National Programmes, Staffing Pattern, Job responsibility of Medical Officer and Para medical staff.

Medical Officer of PHC had shown the infrastructure of PHC viz Labour Room, Operation Theatre, Indoor Ward, Medical Store etc. Health Worker (Female) briefed the students about Immunisation and MCH services provided by them. From 1pm to 2pm lunch was served.

In the Post lunch session, students creativity prepared on 4 topics allotted to them on earlier days in form of charts/posters, regarding health education messages. The preparations about tomorrow's Multidiagnostic Health camp was done and then left the village at 06:00pm

Day 3 - 17/05/18

Students and staff left from D.Y. Patil Medical College at 09:00 am and reached the Mahalaxmi temple in Hanbarwadi at 10:00 am.

Multidiagnostic health check-up camp was conducted in Mahalaxmi temple at Village Hanbarwadi, Tal-Karveer on 17/05/2018 from 10.00 AM to 02:00 pm. Inauguration of the camp was done by the Chief Guest Mrs. Sunita Wadkar (Sarpanch) of the village.


The faculty from all the specialities were actively involved in screening of patients attending the camp. Free consultation from various specialities like Medicine, Surgery, Paediatric, Ortho, ENT, Ophthalm. were given & free medicines were distributed to needy people.

The students witnessed the doctor's role in the provision of Health care at village level and understood the importance of communication skills & a Doctor-Patient interactive session. The students helped the faculty in patient care and were also involved in Health education. Multi-diagnostic health camp got a very good response. Total Beneficiaries of the camp were **84**.

Students were asked to write detail report of 3 days regarding their village experience. Feedback was taken from the students.

The RCOMET Programme conducted at Hanbarwadi village was successful inspite of few hurdles like,

- Provided food quality was not at par. Also quantity was not sufficient.
- Common community hall with basic facilities needed for students & Staff.
- Few more MSW and Class IV are needed to conduct this programme smoothly.



Report of Rural Community Oriented Medical education & Training (RCOMET) Programme.

Rural Community Oriented Medical education & Training Programme (R-COMET) was scheduled and conducted from 18/04/18 to 20/04/18 at Village Gadmudshingi by department of Community Medicine , for IV term students (A batch -36 students).

Day 1- 18/04/18.

Departure of IV Term students (A Batch), faculty members & MSWs from Dept. of Community Medicine to Village Gadmudshingi at 9:30 a.m. Individual introduction of each student and staff was given. Students interacted with village representatives and stake holders.

Students were divided into 4 groups A, B, C and D. Each group consists of 9 students & at least two students who could speak local language i.e. Marathi. Also each group was allotted with one social worker. The social workers assisted the students in orienting them at the ground level. One family per student was allotted for collection of all information of the family and their housing and environmental conditions. Family Survey was completed at 01:00 pm followed by lunch.

Post lunch session was followed by ice breaking and friendly interaction within the groups along with cultural activities .Debriefing of activities and data collection was done.

Tea and Snacks were served at 05:00pm followed by a discussion on the collected family data. Students identified some problem areas in the community which were discussed with supervising teachers. Under guidance of teachers each group was given a problem area for community intervention to be worked upon next day. These problem areas are as follows,

Group A: Personal Hygiene

Group C: Lifestyle Modification

Group B: Nutrition

Group D: Breast Feeding

The team returned to college by 06:30pm.

Day 2- 19/04/18.

Departure of students & staff from Dept. of Community Medicine at 09:00am.

Students visited Primary Health Centre Gadmudshingi at 10:00 a.m. Dr. T. A. More Assistant Prof., Dept. of Community Medicine briefed the students about the Healthcare delivery system in the rural setup. He also gave information of National Programmes, Staffing Pattern, Job responsibility of Medical Officer and Para medical staff.

Medical Officer of PHC had shown the infrastructure of PHC viz Labour Room, Operation Theatre, Indoor Ward, Medical Store etc. Health Worker (Female) briefed the students about Immunisation and MCH services provided by them. ASHA workers shared their work experience with the students. Between 01 pm to 02 pm lunch was served and students got some free time to relax.

In the Post lunch session, students prepared on topics allotted to them on earlier days in form of charts/posters, regarding health education messages. The students had creatively prepared their charts and active participation of students was experienced.

After Tea & snacks a self defence training session was conducted by Mr Ram Powar, Physical trainer and his team. Our students and local village girls participated in training session and benefitted. Total beneficiaries were 35.

The Propaganda about tomorrow's Multidiagnostic Health camp was done and then left the village at 06:30pm.

Day 3-20/04/18

Departure of students and staff from D.Y. Patil Medical College at 09:00 am and reached the Gram Panchayat hall at 10:00 am.

Multidiagnostic health check-up camp was conducted in Biroba mandir at Village Gadmudshingi, Tal-Karveer on 20/04/2018 from 10.00 AM to 02:00 pm. Students had visited the families and motivated them for attending the Multidiagnostic camp. Inauguration of the camp was done by the Chief Guest Mrs. Pratima Satej Patil.

The faculty from all the specialities were actively involved in screening of patients attending the camp. Free consultation from various specialities like


(Medicine, Surgery, ObGy, Paediatric, Skin, Ortho, ENT, Ophthalm.) & Free distribution of medicines was done.

The students witnessed the doctor's role in the provision of Health care at village level and understood the importance of communication skills & a Doctor-Patient interactive session. The students helped the faculty in patient care and were also involved in Health education. Multi-diagnostic health camp got a very good response. Total Beneficiaries of the camp were **160**.

Students were asked to write detail report of 3 days regarding their village experience. Feedback was taken from the students.

The RCOMET Programme was successful inspite of few hurdles like,

- Long waiting for getting the transport facilities
- Limited Class IV staff at Department.
- Lack of availability of adequate washroom facilities and
- Minimal participation of local villagers and support from village leaders.
