
He trained the undergraduate students for privacy setting of these routinely used social media networks. He demonstrated the proper use of google image in the study and its application in research.

The lectures was organised for first and second year MBBS students and the total number of beneficiaries along with the faculty were 225 who enjoyed the session.

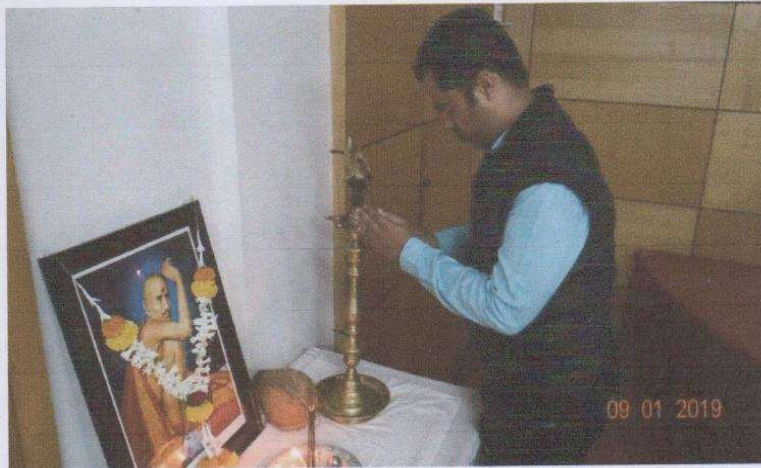
After the completion of the talk, the guest speaker was honoured with a memento and certificate. The session ended with vote of thanks.

**Report of (RCOMET) Programme, Parite.**

Rural Community Oriented Medical education & Training Programme (R-COMET) was scheduled and conducted from 24/07/18 to 26/07/18 at Village Parite by department of Community Medicine, for IV<sup>th</sup> term students (Batch - B ) (Total – 38)

### **Day 1- 24/07/18.**

Departure of IV<sup>th</sup> Term students, faculty members & MSWs from Dept. of Community Medicine to Village Parite at 9:30 a.m. Individual introduction of each student and staff was given. Students interacted with village representatives and stake holders.

Students were divided into 5 groups Each group consisted of 7-8 students & at least two students who could speak local language i.e. Marathi. The social workers assisted the students in orienting them at the ground level. One family per student was allotted for collection of all information of the family and their housing and environmental conditions. Family Survey was completed at 02:00 pm followed by lunch.

Post lunch session was followed by ice breaking and friendly interaction within the groups along with cultural activities .Debriefing of activities and data collection was done.

Tea and Biscuits were served at 05:00pm followed by a discussion on the collected family data. Students identified some problem areas in the community which were discussed with supervising teachers. Under guidance of teachers each group was given a problem area for community intervention to be worked upon next day. These problem areas are as follows - Personal Hygiene, Nutrition, Lifestyle Modification, Breast Feeding & Weaning, **Prevention of Malaria & Dengue.**

The team returned to college by 06:30pm.

### **Day 2 - 25/07/18.**

Departure of students & staff from Dept. of Community Medicine at 09:00am.

Students visited Primary Health Centre at 10:00 a.m. Dr. T. A .More Assistant Prof., Dept. of Community Medicine briefed the students about the Healthcare delivery system in the rural setup. He also gave information of National Programmes, Staffing Pattern, Job responsibility of Medical Officer and Para medical staff.

Health Worker (Female) briefed the students about Immunisation and MCH services provided by them.

In the Post lunch session , students prepared on topics allotted to them in form of charts / posters, regarding health education messages. The students had creatively prepared their charts. Students also prepared a skit on "**Prevention of Dengue**" and Active participation of students was experienced.

The Preparations about tomorrow's Multidiagnostic Health camp was done and then left the village at 06:00pm .

### **Day 3 -26/07/18**

Departure of students and staff from D.Y. Patil Medical College at 09:00 am

Multidiagnostic health check-up camp was conducted in Jotiba mandir at Village Parite, on 26/07/2018 from 10.00 AM to 02:00 pm. Students had visited the families and motivated them for attending the Multidiagnostic camp.

The faculty from all the specialities were actively involved in screening of patients attending the camp. Free consultation from various specialities like (Medicine, Surgery, Obgy, Paediatric ,Skin, Ortho, ENT, Ophthalm.) & Free distribution of medicines was done.


The students witnessed the doctor's role in the provision of Health care at village level and understood the importance of communication skills & a Doctor-Patient interactive session. **Report of (R-COMET) Programme, Ghotawade.**

Rural Community Oriented Medical education & Training Programme (R-COMET) was scheduled and conducted from 08/05/19 to 10/05/19 at Village Ghotawade by department of Community Medicine, for IV<sup>th</sup> term students ( Batch - B ) Roll No.- 17039 to 17076 ( Total – 34 ) students.

**Day 1- 08/05/19.**

Student orientation for R-COMET programme was arranged for IV term students ( Batch – B ) in demo room of Community Medicine at 9:30 am.

In orientation programme, Dr. S. S. Patil (Asso. Prof. ) discuss about family health study & Data collection to students.

In next session, Dr. J. S. Shete (Assist. Prof.) discuss about communication skills & interview techniques to students.

After that students were divided into 5 groups Each group consisted of 7-8 students & at least two students who could speak local language i.e. Marathi.

**Day 2 - 09/05/19.**

Departure of students & staff from Dept. of Community Medicine at 09:30 am.

Students were divided into groups for family surveys & activities in the village. For each student group the social workers assisted the students in orienting them at the ground level. One family per student was allotted for collection of all information of the family and their housing and environmental conditions. Family Survey was completed at 01:30 pm followed by lunch.

Post lunch session was followed by ice breaking and friendly interaction within the groups along with cultural activities. Debriefing of activities and data collection was done.

Tea and Biscuits were served at 04:00 pm followed by a discussion on the collected family data. Students identified some problem areas in the community which were discussed with supervising teachers. Under guidance of teachers each group was given a problem area for community intervention to be worked upon next day. These problem areas are as follows - Personal Hygiene, Nutrition, Lifestyle Modification, Breast Feeding & Weaning.

Students prepared a skit on “**Prevention of Malaria & Dengue**” and Active participation of students was experienced. The skit was performed in front of villages as well as school students.

The Preparations of tomorrow's Blood sugar test camp was done and then left the village at 04:30pm .

### Day 3 -22/02/18

Departure of students and staff from D.Y. Patil Medical College at 09:30 am.

Under RCOMET programme & Student short term project ( BITMER ), Department of Community Medicine arranged **Screening for Diabetes & Blood sugar test camp** was conducted in Maruti mandir at Village Ghotawade, on 10/05/2019 from 10.30 AM to 02:30 pm. Students had visited the families and motivated them for attending the Blood sugar test camp.

The faculty from all the specialities were actively involved in screening of patients attending the camp. Free blood sugar test & Free consultation from specialist were provided. Camp got a very good response. **Total Beneficiaries of the camp were - 450**

The students witnessed the doctor's role in the provision of Health care at village level and understood the importance of communication skills & Doctor-Patient interactive session. The students helped the faculty in patient care and were also involved in Health education. **Health talk** was given by students on **"Prevention of Malaria & Dengue "**.

Students presented skit play on **"Prevention of Malaria & Dengue "** in front of villagers came for camp.

Students were asked to write detail report of 3 days regarding their village experience. Feedback was taken from the students.

Overall RCOMET Programme was successful with positive response from students as well as villagers.
