#### STUDENT FEEDBACK REPORT


Feedback is taken from students on the teaching learning, administration, and syllabus as well as examinations from time to time.

All feedback is collected at the IQAC where it is then analyzed and report is assessed. The IQAC tables all feedback collected by it and action taken to the Board of Management.


As far as is practical, the results of the feedback are hosted on the website and shared with the respondent stakeholders.


### Q1 You have completed which semester of the MBBS program?

### Q1 How many conferences, updates, seminars, workshops etc have you attended in the last 12 months?







### Q6 Who mostly counsels the relatives of your patients who are in serious condition or in critical care?





#### Q1 Please select college in which you studied







#### Q4 How would you describe your current work?




Q9 If Self-employed, your work place is best described as (Tick as many as are applicable)



Among the alumni, 23% went on for higher education and about 50% got employed either in private or government jobs. A few started their own independent practice these were mostly postgraduate students.


Q10 During the lock down period, you have remained in touch with your patients through different modes. Do share which methods you have used.



During the lock down period, the alumni have remained in touch with their patients through different modes. Most of them through physical one to one contact. Some even gave treatment and counselled patients through telemedicine


Action Taken: - in view of the pandemic the usefulness of telemedicine was acknowledge and it was suggested to include a session on telemedicine for the current batch.






More than 50% of the alumni are working with the government organisation and a approximately one third work in educational institutes. In addition 35% of the alumni also give their time for social and charitable organisations.


This response was encouraging and motivating for all as it shows commendable social responsibility and sensitivity to societal challenges amongst our graduates.

## Q15 How frequently do you attend seminars, conferences etc? (Check whichever are applicable)




All of the alumni have remained in touch with academics by attending conferences, seminars CME, guest lectures etc.

The Twitter handle of the University was not visited by majority respondents while the University Website, Medical College Website and the Alumni Page were frequently visited in recent times.




Q17. Are you aware of any of these facilities in university?

Some of the new avenues started during the lockdown like the simulation and skills center were not known to the alumni. Also 48% did not know about the fellowship programs.


Action taken: - it was decided to widely publicize the newly started programs and to also include a visit to the simulation and skills center in any on-campus alumni interaction

## Q18 Whether the curriculum is designed so as to enhance your knowledge skills and employability?






**Subject**: Report of Survey of Professionals on Curricular Aspects
